3. Lecture on Pharmacovigilance in Ayurveda at Abhilashi Ayurvedic College

On December 16, 2024, Abhilashi Ayurvedic College and Research Institute, Chailchowk, Mandi (H.P.) hosted an insightful lecture on Pharmacovigilance in Ayurveda and its role in monitoring Adverse Drug Reactions (ADRs). The session was led by Dr. Vineeta Negi, a distinguished scientist from the Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS), Pandoh, and attended by faculty, students, and the honorable Vice Chancellor of Abhilashi University, Prof. H.K. Chaudhary.

Dr. Negi highlighted the crucial role of pharmacovigilance in ensuring the safety and efficacy of Ayurvedic medicines. She discussed the identification, reporting, and risk management of ADRs, emphasizing, "Accurate identification and reporting of ADRs are essential to build trust and maintain the global credibility of Ayurveda." She also introduced the Pharmacovigilance Program for Ayurveda, Siddha, and Unani Drugs (PPASU), a Ministry of AYUSH initiative aimed at creating a structured system for ADR monitoring.

In his address, Prof. Chaudhary stressed the importance of integrating pharmacovigilance into academic curricula, noting, "This knowledge equips students to tackle challenges in clinical practice while ensuring patient safety." He also urged the academic community to contribute to the national ADR monitoring network.

The session concluded with an interactive Q&A, where Dr. Negi engaged participants on common ADRs in Ayurvedic practice and strategies to improve patient safety.




