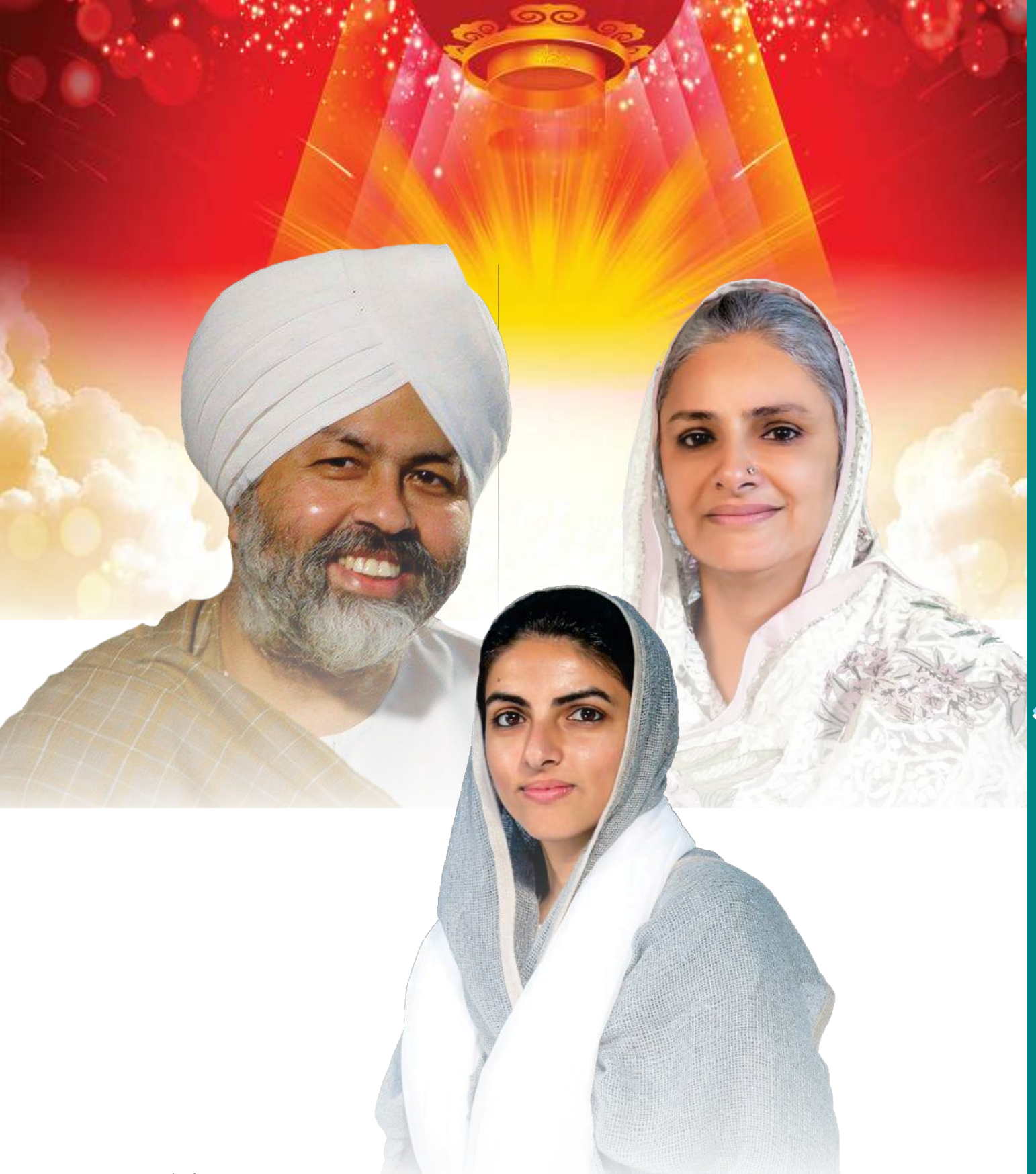

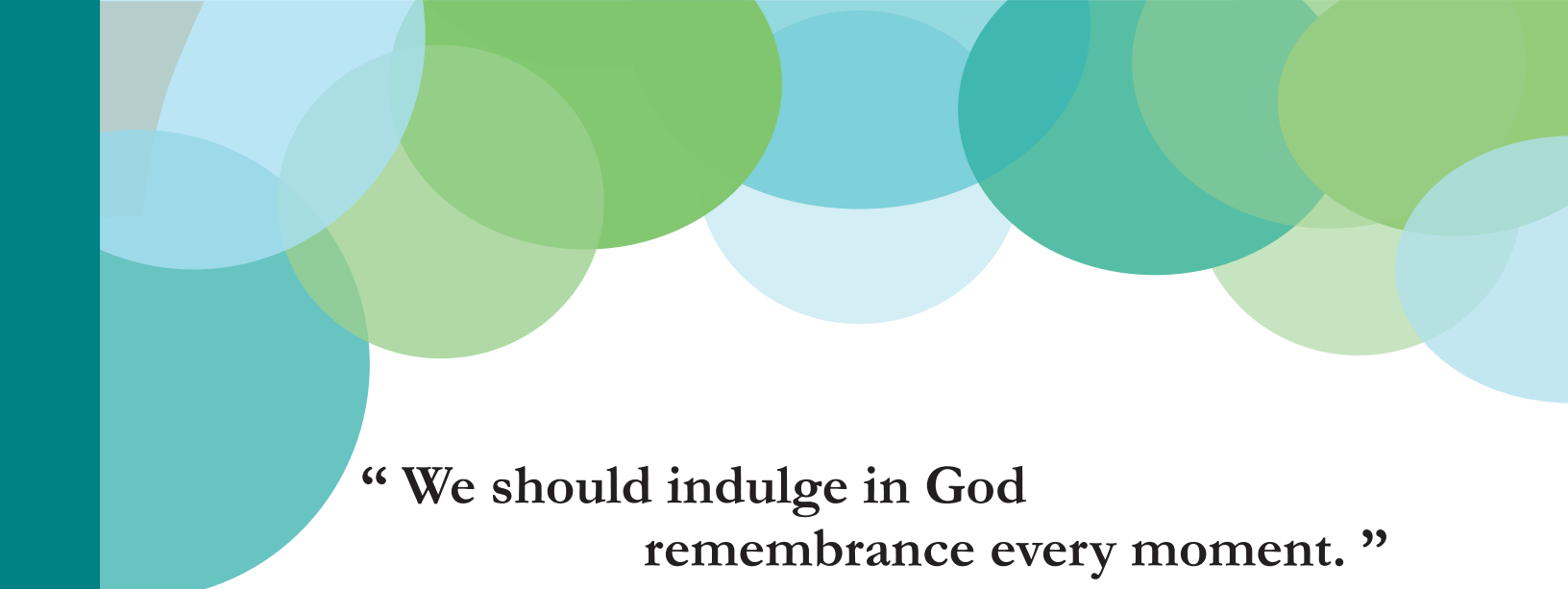

Abhilashi University at Chailchowk, Mandi is established by the Government of Himachal Pradesh vide Abhilashi University (Establishment & Regulation) Act, 2014'. Abhilashi University is a Government recognized University with a right to confer degrees as per Section 2(f) and 22(1) of the UGC Act, 1956. The University received **B+ Grade** from NAAC in its 1st Cycle. The campus of the University is located at Chailchowk near Mandi (H.P.) and surrounded by lush green fields, pine and oak forests thus becomes an ideal place for study in a clean health-oriented environment. The Abhilashi Educational Society, a pioneer in private education in Himachal Pradesh, envisioned this tranquil setting to promote a focused and health-oriented learning atmosphere. There are a number of places worth visiting nearby the University such as Nachan Valley, Jeeuni Valley, Janjehli Valley, Balh Valley, Sundernagar and Mandi towns. One can also enjoy snowfall once a while during the winter season. 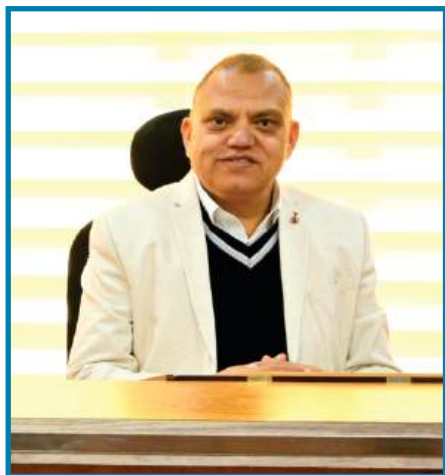

UNIVERSITY ADMINISTRATION



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Admission for Session 2026-27

Abhilashi University aims to impart quality education to its students by applying modern scientific techniques. University follows CBCS and Semester System (Annual System for BAMS, B.V.Sc. & AH, BPT, Pharm D, Pharm D (PB) & Diploma in Pharmacy) for teaching and evaluation. Each semester of study has minimum requirement of attendance and pass percentages in theory and practical examinations. Each course is defined in terms of credit hours for lectures, tutorials and practical classes. A student is registered to each course in the beginning of the programme. The duration of the course is given under the respective faculty. Each semester will have mid-term and end-term semester examinations.

Admission to academic session 2026-27 will be based on National Level/State Level Entrance Tests, Combined Entrance Test (AUCET-2026) and on the basis of marks in qualifying examination.

Documents required at the time of Admission :

The following certificates/documents (self attested by the candidate) be submitted along with the admission form:

1. Three passport size photographs.
2. Matriculation certificate.
3. 10+2 Examination pass certificate.
4. Detailed marks sheets of all semester of graduation in case student is seeking admission in post graduation programme.
5. SC/ST/OBC/ EWS certificate, if applicable as per Govt. policy.
6. Original Character certificate from institution last attended. In case there is a gap in studies character certificate issued by Tehsildar/SDO (C) of the area.
7. Original Migration Certificate. In case it is not available at the time of admission then the student may submit it within one year failing which result of third semester will not be declared.
8. An affidavit in case there is a gap in studies.
9. Copy of Aadhar Card.
10. Low income group candidate may submit income certificate issued by Tehsildar/SDO (C) for scholarship.

Admission in BAMS Course will be done on the basis of merit in NEET and qualifying examination with minimum 50% in 10+2 (Medical) with valid NEET score through counseling by State Authority. The candidate will have to undergo Medical Examination on own expenses in the college after admission

Hospital

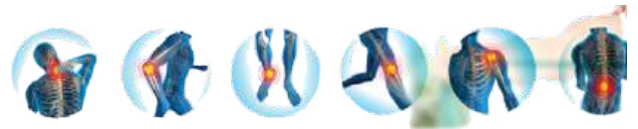

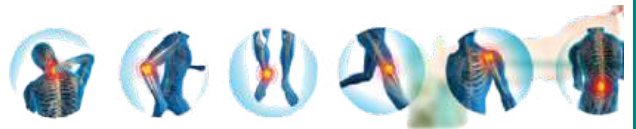

Prof. P.C. Sharma has served at different Research Stations/Krishi Vigyan Kendras of CSK Himachal Pradesh Krishi Vishvavidyalaya, Palampur (HP) for more than 23 years. He superannuated from the post of Principal Scientist (Entomology) in 2024. During his tenure of service, he has gained wide experience in teaching, research, extension and administration in the field of agriculture. Dr. Sharma has published 65 research papers, one book, 10 book chapters, 3 manuals, 3 technical bulletins and 15 scientific folders. Prof. R.K. Asrani is present Dean of the School of Veterinary Sciences, Abhilashi University. He did his B.V.Sc & A.H. (Hons), M.V.Sc (1991) and Ph.D. (2000) in Veterinary Pathology from CCS Haryana Agricultural University, Hisar and has more than 33 years of experience in teaching, research and extension activities. He has served CSK Himachal Pradesh Agricultural University, Palampur in various capacities as Head of the Department, Associate Director (Extension), Associate Director (Research) and University of Strathclyde, Glasgow, UK as visiting Scientist and Chonnam National University, South Korea as Visiting Professor. He has over 140 publications in the peer reviewed National and International journals of repute and has also authored a text book in Veterinary Pathology. He has several awards to his credit conferred by various professional societies and presented research based oral presentations at Australia, UK, Hungary, The Netherlands, Canada, Pakistan, South Korea and Taiwan.

The Faculty of Veterinary Sciences in Abhilashi University was created in 2016, with the start of two years Veterinary Pharmacist training course leading to award of diploma. The Bachelor of Veterinary Sciences & Animal Husbandry (B.V.Sc. & A.H.) degree program was started in the Abhilashi University for the first time in the Private sector in H.P., where the 1st Batch was admitted in the academic session 2024-25 with an intake of 80 students. The students in the 1st & 2nd batch came from fifteen different states of India. The B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree program has the approval of Veterinary Council of India, Govt. of H.P. & HPPEREC. The college owns a well-established Livestock Farm Complex comprising of Dairy, Poultry farm, Sheep & Goat farm and a Piggery unit. Multi-Specialty Veterinary Hospital caters to the need of large and small animal healthcare. Successful completion of B.V.Sc. & A.H. programme entitles the graduates to seek mandatory registration with State or UT Veterinary Council/Veterinary Council of India as a Registered Veterinary Practitioner, qualifying them for employment and practice all over India and abroad.

The School of Veterinary Sciences has well-furnished classrooms and tutorial rooms equipped with teaching tools for the effective delivery of lectures and tutorials as per the requirements. The school has well equipped laboratories and provide diagnostic services as per the requirements of educational program and norms of statutory bodies.

There is well established Library & computer Laboratory equipped with LAN and Wi-Fi connectivity on the campus including hostels and teacher's residences.

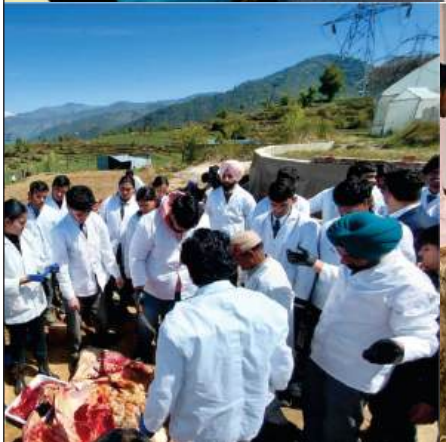
- ❖ **Departmental Labs:** All the departments of the college are well equipped with laboratories for undergraduate teaching as per Veterinary Council of India.

Mentoring

The University has adopted Mentoring System. Faculty members act as mentors of the students. 20 students of each course are placed under each mentor.

The mentor will monitor:

- The academic progress and attendance record of the students.
- Contact parents/ guardians of mentees and inform them about the academic progress, attendance, good qualities and drawbacks of the students, if any regularly.
- Observe behaviour of students in the classroom, hostel as well as in the University or any other noticeable activity of the student to be conveyed to the parents.

Internal Quality Assurance Committee (IQAC)

In pursuance to the Section 25 of the Abhilashi University (Establishment and Regulation) Act the university has constituted Internal Quality Assurance Committee (IQAC).

Cells in Abhilashi University:

Different cells for the welfare of students and employees are:

SC/ST Cell, Sexual Harassment Cell, Women Grievances Cell, Anti- Ragging Cell. The University has constituted cell for the redressal of student's grievances.

The University has appointed an Ombudsman for the grievance redressal of the students as per the guidelines of UGC.

Fee

Fee for different courses will be as approved by the Government of Himachal Pradesh for the session 2026-27 and the details be provided to the students at the time of admission.

Refund of Fee

Fee once paid is not refundable. If a student withdraws before the last date of admission and the seat gets filled with wait listed candidate then the entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of **(Cost of Prospectus- Rs 1000.00 and Registration Fee - Rs. 3000.00)** shall be refunded after the last date of admission, provided the students apply for cancellation of his/her admission before the last date of admission on prescribed format to the Registrar of the University in written or through email to: admissioncell@abhilashiuniversity.ac.in.

Cancellation of Admission

The students are informed that if at any stage it is found that **any fact/ information** provided by the students at the time of admission **is found to be false**, the admission of the candidate will be cancelled by the University without any notice and no refund of fee is admissible in this case.

Scholarship Schemes

Tuition fee waiver for H.P School Education Board topper in the class admitted in our University. All scholarship schemes of H.P. Govt. for higher education are made available to the students. Under the Mukhyamantri Sukh Ashary Yojana, Himachal Pradesh, five students per year will be provided with free academic tuition, as well as complimentary boarding and lodging facilities, which will be nominated by HP Govt.

Reservation in Admissions

At least 25 % seats for admission to each course are reserved for Bonafide Himachali students and the 75% seats open to all over India and abroad (except BAMS where it is 50% for each). Seats for admission in the University, for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, Handicapped students and BPL/IRDP shall be reserved as per policy of the State Government. The 10% seats shall be reserved for the Himachali Bonafide BPL/IRDP candidates as per the provisions made by various Regulatory Bodies.



Eco-Clubs

These clubs play very important role in creating environmental awareness among the students. They undertake various eco-friendly activities motivate students to keep the environment neat and clean by minimization of waste production, proper disposal of waste, effective use of water and undertaking plantation of trees. They also organize Quiz, Essay and Painting competitions regarding various environmental issues and educate the students about the reuse of waste material and preparation of useful products out of the waste.

National Service Scheme (NSS)

The National Service Scheme is an Indian government sector public service program conducted by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports of the Government of India. Popularly known as NSS, the scheme was launched in Gandhiji's Centenary year in 1969. Abhilashi University Chail Chowk, Mandi got approval for two NSS units with 100 volunteers seats each. Mr. Hemant Kapoor working as NSS Programme Coordinators. This unit adopted two villages every year for awareness on social and welfare issues and cleanliness. Every year volunteers get selected for National Camp, NIC Camp, Sports Camp and State level Camps. Students get NSS certificate which is helpful for higher education admission and Govt. jobs too. This unit works on "Not Me But You" only.



Red Ribbon Club

Red Ribbon Club is a movement started by the Government of India in Educational Institutions through which, students will spread awareness about HIV and AIDS. Dr. Bandana Kapoor working as the Red Ribbon Club Co-ordinator and Dr. Ankita Chaudhary is Co-coordinator. Since its inception, it has been conducting various programs such as PowerPoint presentations, poster making and slogan writing competitions to make students aware of HIV and AIDS. Every year University observes World AIDS Day on 1st December, to enlighten the students about the preventive measures and protection against the spread of HIV and AIDS.



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Dean Students Welfare

The office of Dean Students Welfare co-ordinates various activities for the welfare of the students. It aims at social harmony and peace in the campus and makes good citizens of India in addition to good academicians. DSW allots hostel accommodation to students, supervises sports and cultural activities of the students and also organizes debates, declamation contests and quiz competition programs. The office also organizes different cultural and academic tours for students during holidays.



Hostel

'Hostel is home away from home'. At the end of each academic day a student feels completely exhausted and requires recharge of physical and mental energy. All these call for a comfortable residential accommodation which provides the necessary ambience for group interaction and learning situations, for achieving academic excellence.

University has constructed well-furnished separate hostels for boys and girls. It is accepted that the quality and availability of lodging is a major concern to all the students, and due to this our University has given them first class facilities which include the following:

1. Separate hostels for boys and girls.
2. Well furnished, spacious, clean with excellent hygienic, modern style rooms.
3. Lodging is divided into single or double or triple sharing rooms.
4. Rooms are properly ventilated, spacious and equipped with separate beds, study tables and cupboards.
5. Each floor has facility for clean bathrooms and toilets.
6. Hot water is provided through solar heating system.
7. 24-hour water and power facility.
8. Common room with all amenities like television, newspapers and magazines.
9. Wi-Fi facility.
10. Mess facility managed by dedicated teams of employees for cooking and sanitation.
11. Highly dedicated security personnel who ensure proper security to students.
12. Round the clock security of the campus and the hostel managed by a private agency.



Admission

1. Students seeking admission to the hostel will have to apply to the Warden of the hostel (Boys/Girls) at the time of admission in the University.
2. The names of the candidates approved by Dean Students Welfare will be conveyed to the Warden.
3. The selected students will have to take admission in the hostel allotted to them within the stipulated time by paying the requisite fee in the accounts branch of the University.
4. After depositing the fee by the student, Warden will allot room to the student in the hostel. Once the hostel admission is over, Warden will submit the list of hostel boarders to Dean Students Welfare.
5. Allotment of hostel seats will be for the full academic year/semester. In case the resident wants to leave the hostel in the middle of the academic year, he/ she shall pay the hostel charges for the full academic year.
6. The students must sign the undertaking and properly take charge of the material allocated to them in the room on prescribed form available with the Hostel Warden.
7. Admission shall be sought afresh in every academic session. A student may be refused admission without conveying any reason.

Hostel Charges

1. Hostel fee (lodging charges) are approved by the State Govt.
2. Hostel fee including mess charges are to be paid for the full academic year at the time of admission.
3. Residents getting admission to hostel at any time during the session will be charged full fee for the year. The security will stand lapsed after one year of leaving the hostel.
4. In case of non-payment of dues in time or violation of any hostel rule by a resident, the Warden may get his / her room locked or opened for possession without any liability whatsoever. The belongings shall be transferred to the store and will only released after clearance of all dues within one month.

Hostel Rules and Regulations

General Rules:

1. The hostel authorities will not be responsible for any loss/damage of private property such as cash/mobile phone/ scooter/motorcycle and other valuables. The residents are advised to get their vehicles insured against loss, theft and fire.
2. When the student vacates his/her room, he/ she will hand over to the Warden all hostel furniture and other property issued to him/her failing which he/ she will be liable to pay the entire cost of materials issued.
3. Any violation of rules and regulations will be subject to strict disciplinary action and parents of the ward will be informed accordingly. Disciplinary action includes any or all of the following penalties in accordance with the nature and seriousness of the offence: -
 - a. Payment for the repair or replacement of the article(s) damaged.
 - b. Suspension from the hostel for a specified period of time or expulsion from the Hostel/University.
4. A student admitted to hostel cannot withdraw from the hostel during the whole session, if any bodies will do no refund of fee will be made.
5. **Laundry is compulsory** for all staying in the hostel, as washing of clothes is not permitted in the hostel.
6. Hostel is **compulsory for BAMS and B.V.Sc. & A.H.** students for total duration of course.

Note: Orders/ decisions notified from time to time by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor/Dean Students Welfare/ Warden will be binding on the hostel residents.

Attendance and Leave Rules

1. The gates of the hostels will close and open at fixed time. Schedule will be put up on the notice board and the students will strictly adhere to it.
2. It is obligatory on the part of the resident to be present in the hostel on all days except when they go home with the permission of the Warden.
3. Attendance of residents in their respective hostels shall be taken twice every day at the time fixed by the respective wardens. Any resident not present at the time of attendance shall be liable to be marked absent for that day for which he / she should have prior permission or sufficient explanation and the same will be informed to their parents /guardians.
4. If any resident of the hostel wants to take leave from hostel, they will have to provide consent/ permission from their parents /guardians as well as from the Head of the Institute they are studying.
5. Day outing is allowed only for second Saturdays and 4th Sunday from 10: 00 am to 04:00 pm.
6. In the event, the University decides to increase the timings of library and other facilities, the University will make adequate arrangements for girl students.
7. The names of the residents absenting themselves without permission for three days or more may be struck off from the rolls of the hostel and possession of their rooms will be taken by the Warden.



Behaviour & Discipline

All residents shall have their meals in dining hall in the hostel. No resident will take his/her food to his/her room except in case of ill health and with the permission of the Warden. Students will maintain perfect discipline, harmony and peaceful atmosphere in the hostel.

1. Teasing, maltreating or indulging in any sort of ragging is prohibited.
2. Stealing or pilfering Hostel/University or the property of other students is prohibited.
3. Unruly conduct or rowdiness will not be tolerated.
4. Hostel residents are prohibited from climbing over the fencing and boundary walls to get in or out of the Hostel campus.
5. Hostel residents are not allowed to change rooms and transfer any furniture from one room to another room without the prior permission of the hostel warden.
6. Any damage to hostel property must be reported immediately to the hostel warden.
7. Residents will be charged for all damages due to negligence on their part.
8. The residents are expected to be decently, dressed up in hostel premises.
9. The residents are advised not to keep excessive cash, jewelry or other valuables with them.
10. Any form of ragging is strictly prohibited. Any violation may lead to expulsion or any other punishment deemed fit by the Institute.
11. Smoking, consumption of alcoholic drinks, drugs and any other intoxicating substances is strictly prohibited. Any resident found indulging in such practices shall be fined heavily and will be asked to vacate or will be expelled from the hostel immediately without any refund of the hostel fees deposited by the student.
12. Acts of indiscipline, misbehavior, gambling or possession of weapons in the hostel premises including rooms shall be severely dealt with. A resident guilty of any of these violations shall be liable to expulsion or any other punishment deemed fit by the Institute.
13. The management will view any activity of the inmates observed to be seriously prejudicial and detrimental to the smooth and peaceful functioning of the Institute's hostel, disciplinary action will be taken against those found guilty.
14. Suggestion Box provided in the hostel to be opened every 15 days in the presence of Campus Administrator and Student representatives.
15. Before leaving the hostel, every resident shall obtain clearance from the Warden and personally hand over the charge of the room and hostel property to the concerned authority.
16. Making noise and/or creating other disturbances, including the use of electronic or radios, in such manner as to disturb others.
17. Acts of indiscipline, misbehavior, gambling, or possession of weapons in the hostel premises including room. A resident guilty of any of these violations shall be liable to expulsion or any other punishment deemed fit by the authorities. In case a student is expelled from the hostel his/her case for allotment of room in the hostel will only be considered after two semesters.
18. All the students of UG and PG Classes will have to wear the prescribed uniform while in the campus (during winter, University blazer is mandatory).

Visitors and Guests

1. All visitors must make an entry in the visitor's register at the security post and provide all details as requested by guard before entering the campus.
2. No guests shall be allowed to stay with the resident in the hostel.
3. A day scholar is not permitted to visit or stay in the hostel without permission of warden.

Anti-Ragging

As per the ruling of Honourable Supreme Court of India, ragging is a cognizable offence and banned in Abhilashi University. Those who are found guilty of participation in or abatement to ragging can be:

1. Suspended/Expelled from the University.
2. Rusticated from the University up-to two years.
3. Fine up to Rs. 25,000/-.
4. Face rigorous imprisonment up-to three years.

All necessary steps are taken by the University authorities to curb any incident(s) of ragging in the campus. The senior students are made to sign an undertaking that they will abstain from indulging in ragging. Anti-ragging committee and squads are formed in the University to keep a strict vigil over student activities in the campus. Surprise checks are carried out in the hostels from time to time to monitor the activities of students. Anti-ragging posters and banners are displayed at various locations on the campus to dissuade senior students from participating in menace of ragging. Each student of the University submit online undertaking not to indulge in any kind of ragging during his/her tenure in the University, on www.antiragging.in or www.amanmovement.org and provide references number to their School/Department.



Parking Facility

The University has a big parking area to provide space and protection to the two wheelers and four wheelers of the students and employees of the University.



Digital Library

Digital library has twenty four terminals with internet facility.



Computer Labs

In addition to separate computer facilities available in each department, there are two central computer laboratories well equipped with advanced computing systems to provide free internet access to all the students. The computers are of advanced configuration and latest software available for good training facilities. The entire campus is connected through internet facility. The multimedia computers in the campus provide a good facility for the students and employees and make a best quality learning and innovative teaching environment.



University Canteen

Canteen is the ideal place for the staff and the students to refresh after the busy classes schedule. Abhilashi University has a canteen being managed by a private party. University has provided the necessary infrastructure required for the canteen. Canteen is supervised by the University canteen committee. The canteen provides food and snacks to students and staff at nominal rates.

Facilities :

For Physically Challenged Persons

Physically challenged persons are also the part and parcel of the society and they contribute towards the development of the country. In Abhilashi University ramps are constructed for access to each block. In addition, tricycles, wheel chairs, walking sticks, crutches and hearing aids are provided by the University. **There is an elevator installed in the Administrative Block.**

Medical Facility

Abhilashi University has 100 bedded Abhilashi Hospital on the campus with efficient medical and paramedical staff and well-equipped laboratory facilities for clinical investigations of Blood, Urine, Stool, Biochemistry investigations, X-Ray, Ultrasound, ECG, Panchkarma and Ksharasutra etc. Hospital also provides OPD and IPD emergency facilities for the students, employees and the public.

Transportation

The University buses ply on 4 routes i.e. Mandi to University, Sundernagar to University, Nerchowk to University and Hatgarh to University caters to the students of the places on the routes. They have to apply for their bus passes and pay transportation fees as per below table at the time of admission for availing the University bus services for whole year.

Library

Books are the food for the students. Abhilashi University has a fully equipped library which runs on automated software. It is housed in its own building and located centrally in the campus. It feeds to all types of readers by getting issued the books whereas journals, magazines and copies of the articles are for consultation in the library. The University library is equipped with the text books, reference books and research journals of different subjects. Access to online journals is through INFLIBNET and DELNET. The new relevant books are being added to the library stock regularly. The regular timings of the library are extended as per the demands of the students. Abhilashi University is a member of 'National Digital Library of India' club (NDLI) so all the students and staff has access to about 4.6 crore books online. Another unit of library has been opened in the Abhilashi Ayurvedic College and Research Institute (A Department of Abhilashi University). Library is opened from 10 am to 6 pm daily, except Sundays and national holidays. All the students, employees and authorities of the University are the members of the library.



Conference Hall and Seminar Hall

Abhilashi University has five conference halls and one multipurpose hall which are well equipped with modern facilities. They are used as per the needs of the students and staff members for various purposes like presentations and discussions. The academic life in Abhilashi University goes beyond the curriculum and for such activities a centrally located seminar hall is also available. It provides an ideal platform for guest lectures, seminar presentation for and by students, cultural and other functions of the University.



University Auditorium

University auditorium has seating capacity of 800 seats. The auditorium is equipped with all modern facilities with Dolby system. Different functions of the university are organized in this auditorium.



Wi-Fi Facility

The campus is equipped with Wi-Fi facility. Each student has access to internet through his/her id and password.

ERP

For the academics, accounting, examination and resource management the university has the software in ERP.

Sports Facility

Sports activities make the body healthy and strong. University provides sports facilities of both the types, indoors and outdoors games on the campus. There is big playground of 5,000 m² area.

Gymnasium

University has its well-equipped Gymnasium for the use of students and staff.



Extension Programme

Agriculture

Extension education is a two-way process. The School of Agriculture actively involved in extension programme and the farmers of the region are educated about the latest technologies in Agriculture. In order to achieve this, farmers training camps are held in the villages, farmers day depicting the latest technologies are organized at the campus through exhibitions, live exhibits, lectures from experts and entertaining the questions from participating farmers. In the reciprocal process, the experts visit farmer fields to study their problems first hand. The students, as a part of their course curriculum, visit farmers in the rural areas in the villages and acquaint themselves with their problems. In addition, the students go on educational tours to neighboring Agricultural Universities, Research centers and modern farms to acquaint themselves about the latest developments in the field of Agricultural Education.

Pharmacy

To facilitate the link between University and community various extension activities for the welfare of the society in large scale is regularly being conducted through its Pharmacy awareness programmes, providing knowledge on different medically important herbs and their uses and also provide platform in organizing regional and national level workshops, seminars, conferences, newsletters and symposia.

Abhilashi Ayurvedic College and Research Institute

Abhilashi Ayurvedic College and Research Institute is also carrying out the extension of Ayurvedic knowledge to public of the area by adopting village under "Swatch Bharat Mission". Further, the public is also made aware regarding hygiene, sanitation, preventive and precautionary treatment. Furthermore, monthly health camps, blood donation camps and ksharsutra camps for treating the piles patients are also being organized.

Entrepreneurship

Entrepreneurship is the activity of risk taking and deliberately allocating the resources to exploit opportunities in order to maximize the financial return. It is the process of risk taking and deal with uncertainty. In entrepreneurship we have to plan a good business model. The entrepreneurship leads to economic growth of the organization which is must for its sustainability. Abhilashi University is making efforts in the entrepreneurship as starting the agriculture farm for the supply of agricultural products, Pharmacy for medicinal products. An Ayurvedic Hospital at Chail Chowk is already being run by the University.

Grievance Redressal Cells

To make into notice of any grievance of students and employees and its redressal in the University, cells have been constituted. These are: Women Grievances Redressal Cell, SC/ST Grievances Cell, Sikkim Students Grievances Cell and Students Grievance Cell. As per directions from the UGC, the university has appointed Ombudsperson for the redressal of grievances.

Annual Events at Abhilashi University

Abhilashi University organizes a variety of annual events to promote all-round development and active participation of students beyond academics:

1.Cultural Fest: A highlight of the academic year, the Cultural Fest is a student-driven event where participation is mandatory for all students. From planning to execution, every aspect is managed and organized by students, fostering leadership, teamwork, and creativity. It is mandatory for each student to contribute approximately Rs. 2000 or as mutually decided by the students committee towards the event.

2.Annual Sports Meet: Encouraging physical fitness and team spirit, the university hosts an Annual Sports Meet with various indoor and outdoor games. It is an opportunity for students to showcase their athletic talents and build camaraderie.

3.Educational Tours: Regular educational tours are organized to provide experiential learning and industry exposure, enhancing the practical understanding of academic concepts.

4.Seminars & Webinars: The university frequently conducts seminars and webinars featuring experts from academia and industry, helping students stay updated with the latest trends and research in their respective fields.

Jurisdiction

In case of any dispute, decision of the Registrar of Abhilashi University will be final and the territorial jurisdiction for any legal action shall be limited to Chachyot, Distt. Mandi, (H.P.) only.

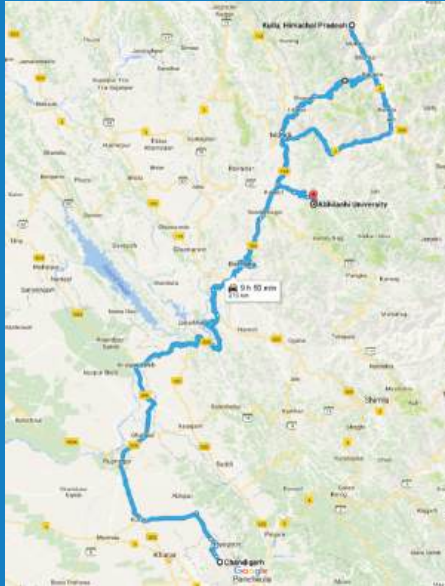
